Background

Torpoint were appointed to build a new structure to accommodate both a contemporary and traditional style of worship and provide an inclusive environment for the local community to use. The building was designed and built in order to service the entire local community and welcome families, children, social groups, over sixties and parent and toddler groups.

Description of Works:

The church and community centre was to be built on an existing graveyard. Torpoint worked with the Home Office to get special permissions and to receive direction and practical support in exhuming and re-siting the graves to a memorial garden.

Description of Works
