Background

The Primary School project included Major redevelopment work on the existing school, together with building a new multi-use hall extension to the rear of the school. The new hall was a steel framed building covered with profile metal sheeting for the roof and cedar timber external panelling for the perimeter walls. Within the new hall were 3 large 'L' shaped roof lights which became integral with the roof and external wall.



Description

1. Demolition of existing kitchen and associated rooms.
2. New Multi Hall steel framed building with connecting lobby
3. Additional WC facilities for Staff
4. Care Suite (Walk in Shower & Disabled WC)
5. Large Curved Wall Storage
6. Breakout Space in Corridor
7. Stair Lift
8. 2 New Class Rooms
9. Architectural Masonry to all internal walls within the new hall
10. Specialist Acoustic ceilings within the new hall
11. New Boiler and Storage room
12. New Kitchen, Stores and WC
